Through this program, DAN will contribute 50% of the cost of the oxygen unit. Applicant/recipient is responsible for all shipping and related costs to destinations both domestic and international. Unit is selected by the applicant. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Full Grant is available to non-profits, certain public safety dive teams, academic and scientific institutions, zoos, aquariums, and similar entities. Unit awarded is at the discretion of DAN and is based on a variety of factors. DAN will cover domestic shipping Applicant/recipient is responsible for all shipping and related costs to destinations outside of the United States.
